



#### A NOTE ON SUSPENSIONS...

Dear Brother Knights,

On July 1, 2011, our total membership was 903. At that time, there were a considerable number of members who had not paid dues in quite some time, most of whom were 3 or 4 years in arrears. Previous administrations had offered amnesty programs which, unfortunately, did not work. This office became an easy target at meetings by several members who demanded to know why these members were still on our rolls and not suspended. They were looking to this office for a "quick fix" to our problem which, quite simply, was not going to happen. There is a lengthy process involved which must be followed to the letter. After consulting the State Membership and Retention Directors, it was agreed that the best way to achieve our goal was to submit 15 to 20 Intent To Suspend notices per month. We knew this would be time consuming, but worth it. Slowly but surely, the numbers began to decrease, from the above mentioned 903 to 803 as of January 1, 2013, then to 770 as of July 1. As I write, the total membership is now 736, a difference of 167. Factor in the new members, transfers, deaths, etc., and the actual suspension number is higher. THANK YOU to those brothers who put their trust and confidence in me. They said, "It couldn't be done" -- but WE DID IT!

#### FROM THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY'S OFFICE....

Dear Brother Knights,

It's that time of year again! Dues invoices will be printed and mailed the first weekend in December. As always, a book of State raffle tickets will be included in the mailing. The raffle has always been a win-win situation since the proceeds assist in keeping the per capita costs down and it's also an instant fund raiser for the Council. For every full book sold, we remit \$9 to the State, the Council keeps \$5 and \$1 remains with the seller, although in most cases the seller donates the dollar to the Council. I would ask that all checks be made payable to Elder Council. Dues and raffle may be combined in one check. Checks made payable to the State will experience a delay in processing. A seperate mailing will be sent to all Honorary Life and Disabled members so that they may have an equal opportunity to participate. If you cannot afford to purchase the entire book, even a few tickets will help. The Council is mandated to sell 77 full books or face an assessment of over \$700. Your understanding and participation is greatly appreciated.

Now that the suspension process from previous years has been completed, we are starting fresh. The Officers of this Council take the obligation of every member to pay his dues in a timely manner very seriously. If any member is experiencing difficulty and finds himself unable to pay his dues, please contact the Grand Knight and/or Financial Secretary. We do have some leeway and will handle these situations on a case by case basis. The billing schedule is as follows: First notice, December. Second notice,
